The fragments thus collected make up a mosaic that is not only virtual and literary. Anton Ivanovic, Joshua Momigliano, Brian Crain, Beatrice Della Rocca are pawns in a game played for a long time in a suspended atmosphere, the outcome of which, however, has the scabrous evidence of reality.
